

GETTING THERE BY CAR:

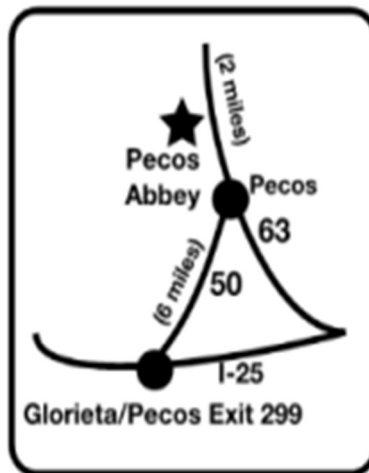
- From Albuquerque drive about 60 miles north past Santa Fe on I-25.
- Continue northeast for about 17 miles on I-25 to the Glorieta/Pecos exit 299.
- Get off at exit 299 and turn left at the stop sign.
- Continue over the highway to another stop sign.
- Turn right at the stop sign on Route 50 and drive 6 or 7 miles into Pecos.
- At the stoplight, turn left on route 63.
- Continue for 2+ miles. The Monastery is on the left.

When you enter the driveway, turn right and go to the end of that drive. Registration will be set up near the East (first) entrance into Tolomei Center.
